Topic: Water System Operations and Concerns

President Serene informed the board that the new pump was installed. Pressure adjustments had since been made. Friday 7 July, it was discovered that the new pump had been installed as the auxiliary pump rather than the main pump. This was switched as of Friday (the 7 <sup>th</sup> ) and everyone is now believed to have good pressure.			
Member Kathy Weidler told the Board that it takes a significant amount of time (15 minutes) to get water to her bathroom, but she acknowledged that her home was situation high on the lot and her bathroom was a far distance from where the water entered the home. President Serene verified that Technical Advisor Carl			

Member Kathy Weidler told the Board that it takes a significant amount of time (15 minutes) to get water to her bathroom, but she acknowledged that her home was situation high on the lot and her bathroom was a far distance from where the water entered the home. President Serene verified that Technical Advisor Carl Schuman checked Ms. Weidler's pressure at the meter the day before and it registered at 48 psi which was very close to the 50 psi standard for the BSTWSC water system. President Serene noted that the State standard is 35 psi. President Serene recommended that Ms. Weidler have a plumber out to investigate

The Board and members briefly discussed water pressure readings throughout the system, sharing the various readings over a number of days. Member Clifton Tierney asked if the Board intended to try to maintain a water system standard pressure of 50 psi even as new customers were added, and received confirmation that that was the Board's intention.

because this was not likely to be an issue with the water system since she was getting 48 psi at the meter.

## Bear Springs Trails Water Supply Corporation Meeting Minutes

Member David Ketterer inquired as to why the Board believed that the water system was built to adequately support 75 homes. President Serene responded that the information came from the previous water company, but that this did not mean that 75 homes would have a standard of 50 psi. Member Ketterer stated that the community had not had pressure problems until more homes were built and customers came on line. He believe that in addition to pressure, volume was also an issue. He further argued that the configuration of the water system (not being a closed loop) contributed to the problem. Member Ketterer requested that an engineering analysis of the water system be conducted to ensure that the system remains adequate to support the maximum number of future water customers (50-55 customers). The Board agreed to look into having a water system analysis done, and to continue to monitor the system as new customers were added.

President Serene notified the Board that BSTWSC had received a chlorine monitoring violation because the water operator failed to file the required report. President Serene indicated that the testing had been done and fell within standards, but the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Chlorine Monitoring report was not filed. The water operator has since provided the report to TCEQ.

President Serene notified the Board that our current water operator had submitted his resignation since he was getting out of the water operator business. Vice President Watson was currently searching for a replacement. The current water operator agreed to continue providing his services until the replacement was found.
