Serene informed them of his prior notification of the change in water operator to the TCEQ licensing team.

President Serene informed the Board that the IRS application for tax exemption has been assigned to an exempt organization specialist for further investigation. President Serene received a letter dated January 12, 2018 indicating that the application case had been assigned because an IRS Specialist was notifying BSTWSC that the BSTWSC Certificate of Formation was downloaded from the website and placed in the application file. Note: President Serene provided a copy of the Article of Incorporation with the application.

TCEQ sent a postcard to BSTWSC indicating the operational evaluation is a review of your source water treatment processes and distribution operations to determine the cause of high total Trihalomethane (TTHM) and Haloacetic Acid (HAA5) results to identify actions to reduce disinfectant byproduct formation or to prevent future violations. President Serene went into TCEQ's system and reviewed the last four reports on TTHM and confirmed that we did not exceed allowable levels. The max level for TTHM is 80ugs/liter. BSTWSC highest level was 8.2ugs/liter. The other levels were "0." HAA5 max level is 60. Our highest level was 3.9.

The monthly coliform test dated 24 January showed no coliform. Free chlorine residual was .82mg/liter. Normal is between .2 and 1.0mg/liter.

The annual cross connection control program (Backflow Preventer Inspections) will occur within the next couple of weeks. Vice President Watson requested that the cost of the inspection be included in the monthly invoice instead of collecting separate checks from individuals. Treasurer Serene agreed to add \$45 to the water bill of those water customers wishing to participate.

Director Flint Lemon notified the Board that our website was down due to not confirming that everything was "correct with the account" before reactivation. Director Lemon will follow up to ensure it is back up asap.
