P. Serene informed the Board that TCEQ received BSTWSC's 2017 Consumer Confidence Report Monday 2 July 2018.

Pollution Control Services Report monthly results are as follows: June 25, 2018 sample test results showed chlorine residual levels at .96mg/l and coliform was absent, so within standards.

May 21, 2018 Test Results: .65 mg/l chlorine residual levels and coliform was absent.

Note: .2 to 1.0 milligram/liter is considered normal for chlorine residual levels.

The Texas Department of State Health Services Volatile Organic Compounds Analysis Report showed all test results were within standards. Note: Quarterly sample was collected on 4 April 2018.

P. Serene inquired if the backup pump and alternator had been installed. Technical Advisor Schuman informed the Board that the stainless steel fittings had been installed. V.P. Watson indicated that he would stop by the pump house and confirm that the installations were completed.
