TCEQ 3 Year Inspection Report Update Discussion: President Serene reported the ultrasonic inspections of the water system pressure tank had been conducted and results provided to TCEQ. The tank met all standards.

President Serene informed the Board that the BSTWSC Water Operator has been approved to take the New Construction Inspector exam (for backflow water prevention). The date for his exam is still pending. Jason must take and pass the exam prior to conducting any new construction inspections. This item is tabled until this action is completed.

## Bear Springs Trails Water Supply Corporation Meeting Minutes

President Serene asked Vice President Watson to provide him an electronic copy of the BSTWSC plant manual so that he can add the required procedures for testing when the pressure drops below 20 psi to satisfy a finding in the TCEQ 3 year inspection. President Serene stated he had heard nothing further from TCEQ concerning the finding we had improperly conducted a lead and copper sampling from an outside hose bib. He also reported our water operator is still working on RTCR sampling plan.

There is no new information from BST Owners Association President Ray Nolan regarding the establishment of an audit committee(s) for both the owners association and BSTWSC water company. There has also been no further information from water customer David Ketterer since providing him with the financial records of the water company.

Vice President Watson is still seeking a source for a alternator for the pumps at a lower cost. If a lower cost source can not be located, we will have the water operator manually alternate the pumps on a weekly basis.

Vice President Watson reported that J & L plumbing repaired the leak in the front cul-de-sac and elevated the shut off valves for that section. During excavation they discovered that the supply line in at least that section is SDR35 which is a lower grade that the schedule 40 PVC. In the long term we will look at installing a pressure reducer for this section as the increased pressures at the low end of the subdivision could eventually cause a blow out. It will probably be around \$2,000 for this installation which would be less than the cost of an emergency repair in the case of a blow out. He also reported that in conjunction with future repairs we will locate and elevate 4 other shut off valves in the system.

Water system testing results are as follows:

The following water system microbial sampling was performed. In cycle testing results are as follows: December 10, 2018: chlorine residual level at .83 mg/l and coliform absent, January 4, 2019 chlorine residual level at 1.05 mg/l and coliform absent conducted as a result of the planned water outage in the front cul-desac for the repair of the leak.

Note: .2 to 1.0 milligram/liter is considered normal for chlorine residual levels.

Because of complaints by 2 customers on the upper loop Vice President Watson confirmed that the pumps are turning on at 85 psi and shutting off at 105 psi. He recorded in excess of 60 psi at their meters or a neighboring meter. It appears one is losing at least 20 psi between the meter and the home, and the other is losing 30 psi. Given the 20 psi variance at the pump house, the readings at their meters should not fall below 40+ psi. We do not believe there is any blockage on the system side or in their meters. Both meters have been replaced. No other homeowners on this line have had any problems with their pressure.
