Topic: Water System Operations and Concerns

Key Points:

- Mr. Serene reported that he had filed the Bear Springs Trail Water Supply Company Tariff and "Max Load" capacity with the Texas Public Utility Commission per their request.
 - He also briefed that he would review the Tariff and determine if it needed updating and inform the directors at the December meeting.
 - He also briefed that he had not provided a critical load list to Bandera Electric as BSTWSC has a backup generator.
- Mr. Serene briefed that due to the well being dug before the formation of the Ground Water District, a formal permit had never been received. He contacted the district and provided a new application for the well and was told it should be approved when voted on.
- Mr. Serene briefed that TCEQ has jurisdiction over enforcement of our water usage, rather than the Bandera County River Authority and Water District.
- Mr. Serene briefed that the following water tests had been performed:
 - Microbial Testing
 - 26 October 2023 Chlorine residual level at .85 mg/l and absent coliform

Note: .2 to 1.0 milligram/liter is considered normal for chlorine residual levels.

 Mr. Watson briefed that he would discuss with the water operator regarding replacing the PVC plumbing used at the water pumps with Stainless Steel plumbing.
