#### **Topic: Water System Operations and Concerns**

#### **Key Points:**

- Mr. Serene reported that he had received the report for the annual testing that was performed on 10 August 2023. Report indicated that all levels were normal. He also reported that he had received the report for the Lead and Copper testing that was recently performed. Samples were taken from 10 different homes in the subdivision and all levels were normal. Mr. Serene provided the results to the 10 homes that the samples were taken from.
- Mr. Serene briefed that the following water tests had been performed:
  - Microbial Testing
    - 23 August 2023 Chlorine residual level at .89 mg/l and absent coliform

Note: .2 to 1.0 milligram/liter is considered normal for chlorine residual levels.

- Mr. Duke reported that the water alarm had activated in the well house on the weekend of 8
  September due to the primary pump leaking. The pump was turned off and the secondary pump was turned on. The water operator was notified and he repaired the leak.
- Mr. Duke informed the directors that he would be on vacation for several months and had made arrangements for Mr. Watson to read the meters each month and Mr. Lemon would do the weekly welfare checks on the well.

Mr. Serene briefed that he was still monitoring the water usage and it had gone up for the month of August. He also stated that the Bandera County River Authority and Groundwater District had changed the watering policy and that watering of any type was not allowed.
